It's not just the gorgeous beaches that make Maui the subject of envy: Easy access to pristine seafood and tropical fruit is enough to make any continent-based chef jealous. Here's our guide to the island's dining destinations:

**Mala Wailea** This new oceanfront spot goes to even greater lengths to create clean, local flavors. Balinese spices enliven a brown-rice stir-fry with line-caught island fish (\$34), while the mashed molokai (\$9)--the local purple potatoes--are creamy enough to forego butter.
